The purpose of this research was to study the standard of working , studied in Tambol Municipalities in Muang Kamphaeng Phet District ,Kamphaeng Phet Province The sample group for this study comprised 153 municipal officers and 17 experts in Amphoe Muang kamphaeng Phet, Kamphaeng Phet Province.

In order to find the conditions, the problems and the needs of the study, the research instruments were in-depth interview ,and a constructed 5 - level rating scale questionnaire with open - ended questions the reliability of 0.94 was used as a tool to collect data. The research instruments were tested for content validity by experts. The statistics employed for data analysis were percentage, mean, standard deviation.

The research findings were as follows :

1. The overall result of the research was medium . The good result was the public services, and the poor result was the management .
2. The guidelines for the development of the research can be divided into four parts
1)The management , global warming activity and the activity to protect and uphold the monarchy for stability should be involved in internal control system and the risk management . 2)The Personnel Management and the municipal council affairs, self assessment should be provided and reported periodically. Laws and regulations related to the municipal council affairs should be set in a room or a corner that can be actually used. 3)The financial management , officers who work for the financial

division should be trained about honesty and integrity. The procurements in the municipalities should follow the procurement regulations strictly. 4)Public services , Projects or activities on the conservation of natural resources and the environment must always be added in the municipal law.
